- Demonstrate the ability to work with parents, teachers, and administrators and other educational partners
- Be activity teaching and planning to continue to teach in a program that serves students with emotional, behavioral and/or autism spectrum disorders or take a leadership position in the field of education beyond the classroom.
- Demonstrate an advocacy position for students with disability in their community.
