


Why do students drop out? It's complicated!

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Dropout Screening – Early Warning Systems

Data collection system to identify at-risk students

- Flags key indicators to intervene effectively:
 - Attendance
 - Behavior
 - Course Performance
 - Engagement
 - Demographics
 - Disability Status
 - Grade Retention
 - Mobility

THE ABC'S OF IDENTIFYING POTENTIAL DROPOUTS Attendance: 62% of dropouts surveyed had been skipping school at least once a week. Behavior: 25% of 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders had been suspended at least once

CLASSWORK: More than 40% of dropouts had failed at least 2 classes*





Improve parent communication!






