Award Description: The Midwest Symposium awards a plaque to an individual who has exhibited outstanding career service and leadership to the field of emotional/behavioral disorders (EBD) and autism spectrum disorders (ASD) on a national level. The recipient will also be reimbursed for expenses to attend the Symposium to receive the award in person. The Midwest Symposium Awards Committee will select the winner. Nominations will be accepted from the Planning Committee and any interested person.

Award Criteria: The following criteria are used to determine the recipient. (Please enclose documentation with forwarding a nomination.) The first criterion receives the most weight.

- 1. Outstanding career service on the national level to the field of EBD and ASD, including work in professional organizations, advocacy activities, and other nonprofit activities grant work and research pursuits;
- 2. Professional contributions leading to the advancement of the field of EBD and ASD;
- 3. Seminal contributions to the field of scholarship in EBD and ASD;
- 4. Recognized career of leadership to the field of EBD and ASD;
- 5. Prominence in the field of E/BD over an extended period of time.
